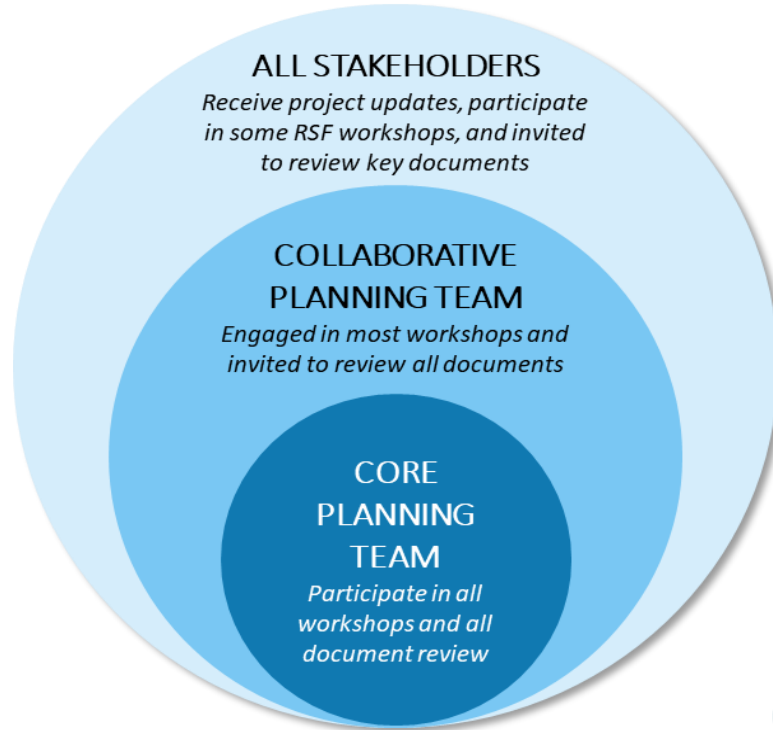

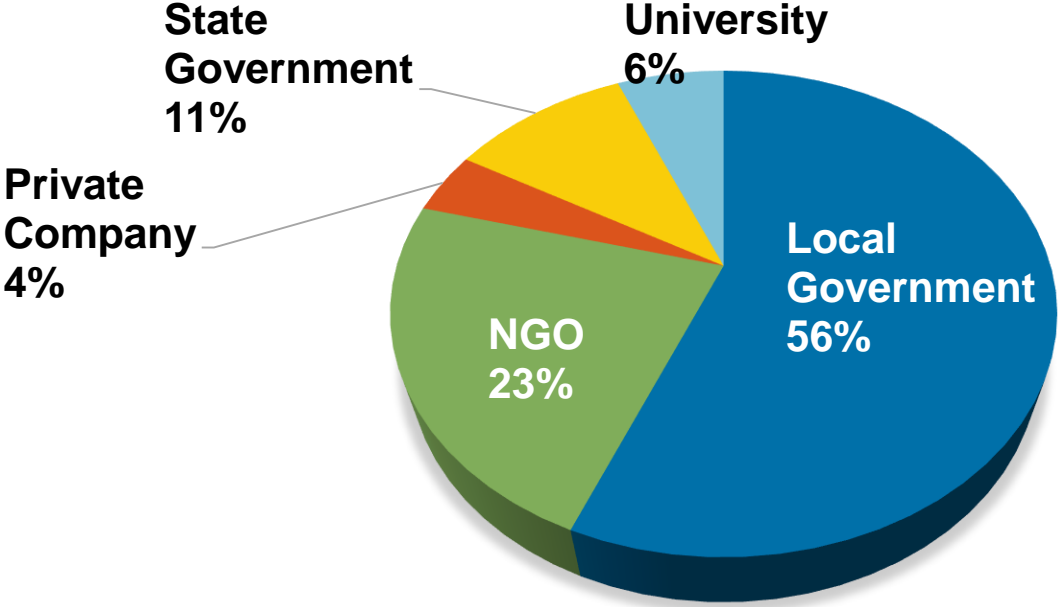

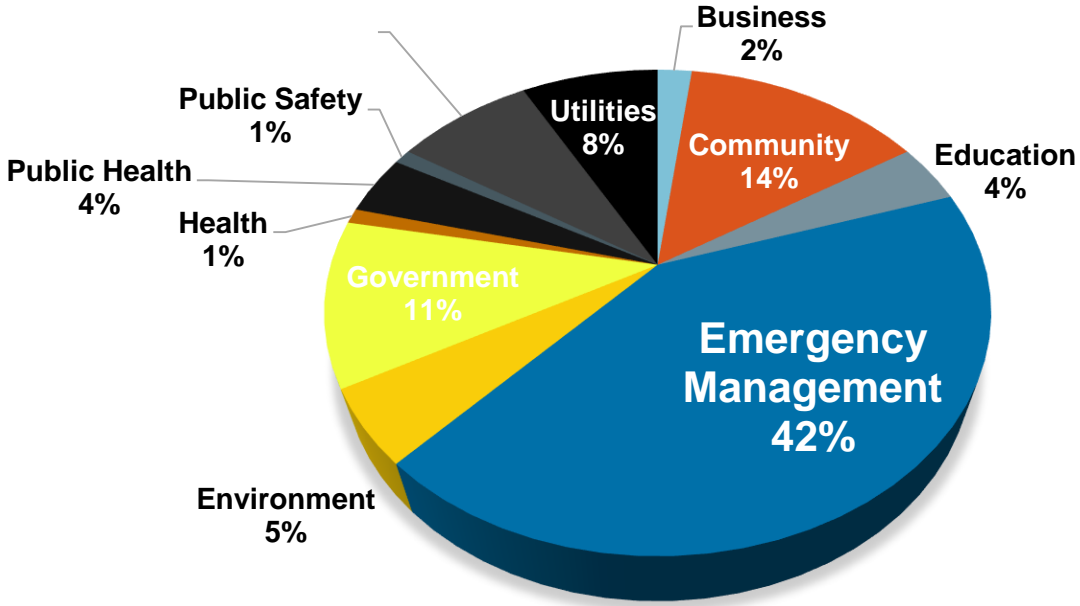
RDPO Recovery Conference March 11-12, 2019

Recovery Conference Outcomes

Positive Outcomes:

- “People-centered recovery” vs. “project-centered”
- Lessons learned from real-world examples: Christchurch and from Bay Area Lifelines effort
- Very positive feedback from participant surveys about usefulness of the plenary sessions

Challenges Observed:

- Mobilizing stakeholder engagement from whole community
- Challenge to link the RSF discussions, they’re so interconnected
- Volume of information and limited timeframe
- Still need and want more on equity approach in our region

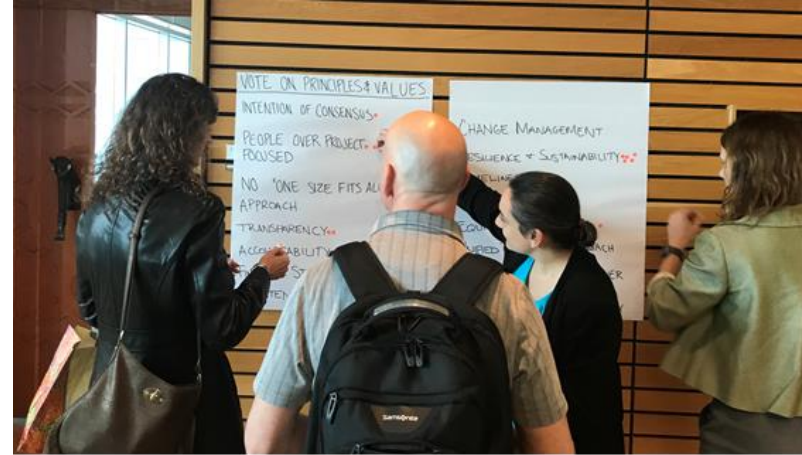
Governance Workshop April 3, 2019

- Money
- Time
- Information

Governance Workshop Key Takeaways

- We validated:
 - Existing regional organizations that are well positioned for key roles in recovery coordination
 - The list of these regional organizations and mechanisms
- We need to continue discussions on:
 - Authority – Who has power?
 - Decision-making – Who makes decisions?
 - Accountability – How do other actors make their voice heard and how account is rendered?
 - Activation, transitions, and scalability of the ultimate governance model
